



Anne of Green Gables 2022 Company Contract

- I accept the place offered to me in the Company of the London Children's Ballet for the 2022 season.
- Unfortunately, I am unable to accept the place offered to me and I understand that you will give my place to a dancer on the waiting list.
- I agree to attend **ALL** rehearsals for which I am called. I have a copy of the general rehearsal schedule for **January to May 2022**. I will **NOT** ask to miss a rehearsal or performance as I understand permission will be **NOT** be granted, except for an audition for a full-time vocational school.
- I confirm there will be no conflict with LCB rehearsals in relation to any other activities I participate in (other than an audition for a vocational school) including all ballet school shows, ballet company auditions or shows, festivals, ballet exams, family events, academic examinations etc. I confirm I have checked the dates with my ballet teachers and my school.
- I will make a £100 contribution towards my costumes which the Company keeps, new performance shoes and tights (arranged by LCB) and an LCB company t-shirt. **(If this payment will be difficult for you and you would like to apply for a grant to cover this cost, or pay in instalments, please contact the LCB office).**
- I understand LCB is a Registered Charity and LCB raises funds to cover the cost of my participation. If asked, I agree to support LCB for one day or evening to participate in an outreach project or fundraising event.
- I understand LCB may like to talk to a family member, parent, grandparent, guardian over the course of rehearsals to get feedback, hear interesting stories for publicity, etc.
- I understand and agree to adhere to LCB's mobile phone policy. **Strictly no mobile phones allowed in the rehearsal room.** For communication purposes dancers are permitted to bring them, but they must be put in the 'Valuables Box' upon signing in for the duration of the rehearsal. We want dancers to interact with each other and concentrate on the choreography.
